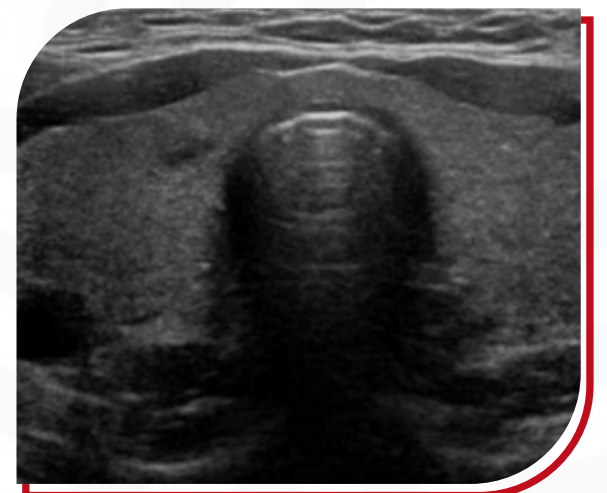
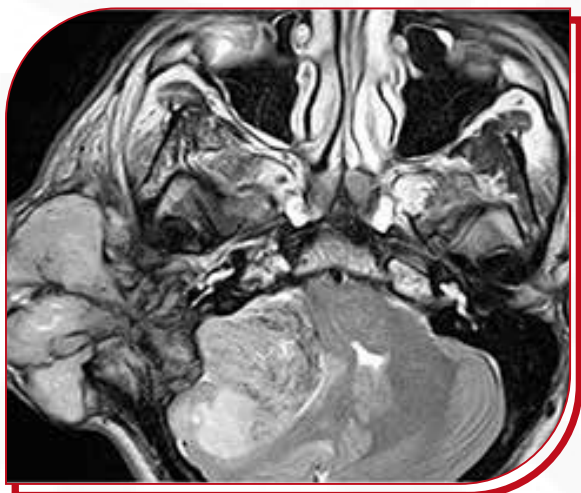

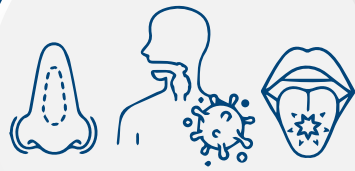

SCIENTIFIC ORAL PAPER

- ➔ Registration of first author for this conference is mandatory.
- ➔ To submit your abstract kindly [Click Here](#).

GUIDELINES FOR ORAL PAPER ABSTRACT

- ➔ Paper abstract must be in English with a word limit of 250 words only.
- ➔ Kindly adhere to the timings.
- ➔ Paper topic must be related to Head & Neck Radiology.
- ➔ Name of the presenting author to be followed by names of co-authors maximum of 6 co-authors and lastly name of Institution with full affiliation must be provided.
- ➔ Please ensure that patient confidentiality is protected. No names, hospital numbers or any other identifying information can appear in the presentation.
- ➔ Please do not include references, acknowledgments, graphics, tables, or figures in the abstract body.
- ➔ The body of the abstract should be structured as follows:
 1. Aims and objectives,
 2. Methods and Materials,
 3. Results,
 4. Conclusion
- ➔ All presentations should be prepared on Microsoft 2007 PowerPoint or later version. Each presentation will be for 8 minutes and 2 minutes for discussion.
- ➔ E-mail should be sent under the subject of the e-mail 'Abstract for Oral Paper ISHNR'.
- ➔ Last date for oral paper presentation submission is **30th September 2024**

- ➔ These will be displayed in auto-run format at the conference venue.
- ➔ Paper topic must be related to Head & Neck Radiology.
- ➔ Please ensure that patient confidentiality is protected. No names, hospital numbers or any other identifying information can appear in the presentation.
- ➔ You may be asked to be present at the time of judging.
- ➔ This will be in PowerPoint format. Maximum 20 slides (excluding title and references)
- ➔ Poster will be judged on content, quality of slides, clarity of presentation, time management and clinical relevance.
- ➔ The primary author should have registered for the meeting.
- ➔ The PowerPoint presentation should be structured as follows in the case of the Educational E – Poster
 - ▶ Aims and Objectives
 - ▶ Contents: Imaging findings / procedure / radiological signs
 - ▶ Summary and teaching point



THE POWERPOINT PRESENTATION CAN BE STRUCTURED AS FOLLOWS IN INTERESTING CASE:

- ➔ The PowerPoint for display at the conference should have a maximum of 7 slides to be presented in a quiz format.
- ➔ Authors must submit five questions and answers as part of their presentation to reinforce educational value.

- ➔ Last date for E Poster presentation submission is **30th September 2024**

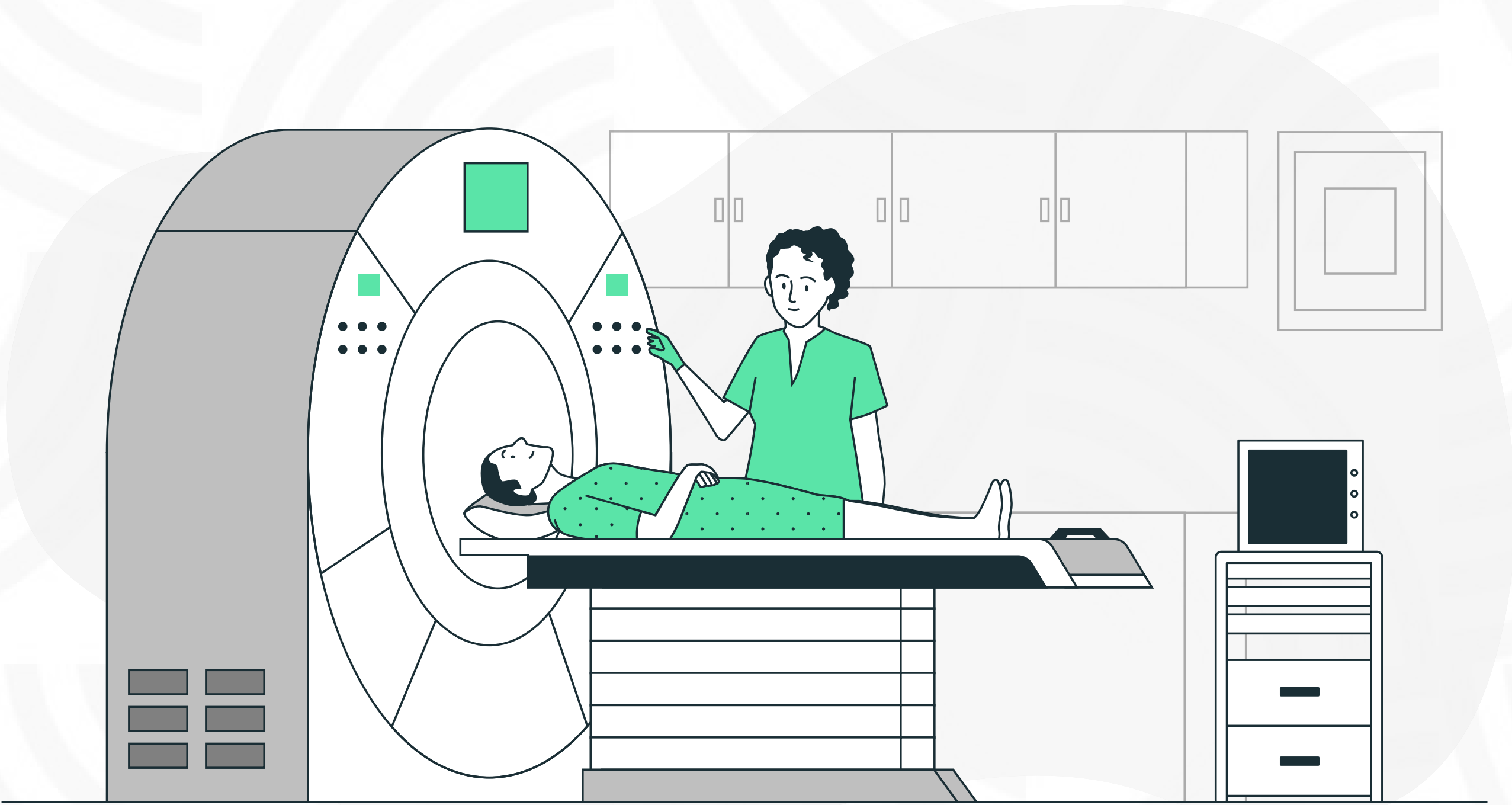

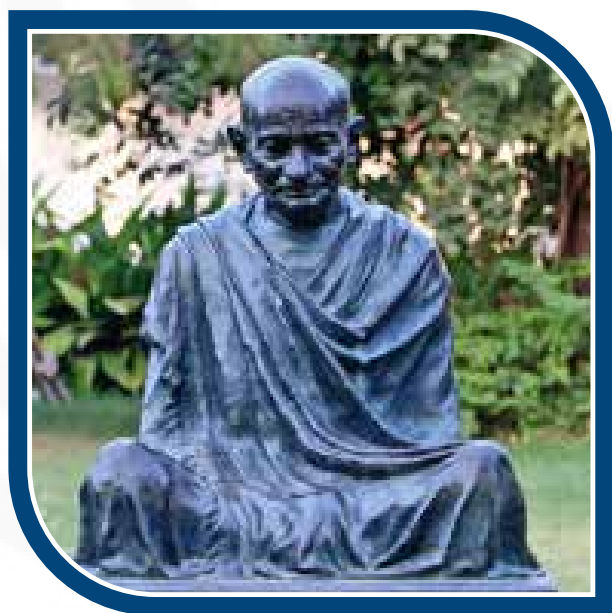

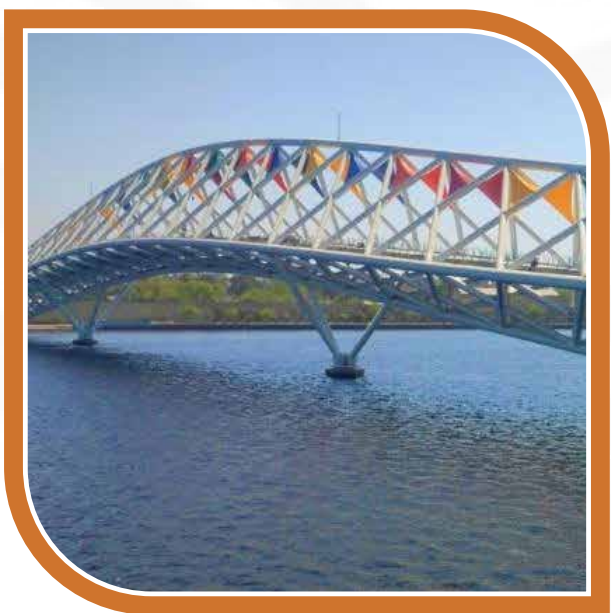
