#### RISING Star Award Guidelines

The RISING Star Award has been instituted to encourage and recognize outstanding young talent in the field of Head and Neck Radiology and Interventions. This award provides a dedicated platform for early-career radiologists to showcase their original work, research, and innovations.

#### Eligibility

- Open exclusively to early-career radiologists, including:
  - Young Radiologists with up to 5 years of experience post MD/DNB/DMRD
  - Senior Residents / Registrars
  - · Radiology Fellows
  - Junior Consultants
- Candidates should be within 5 years of completing their Radiology degree/diploma at the time of presentation.
- Registration for the conference is mandatory
- ISHNR membership is preferred but not mandatory

#### Topics

- Submissions must be related to Head and Neck Radiology only.
- Suggested areas include but are not limited to: Head and Neck Oncology, Skull base & Face, Neck
   Thyroid, Advanced imaging techniques in head and neck and miscellaneous

#### **Presentation Slots and Award**

- A total of 3 presentation slots are available in a dedicated RISING Star session during the conference (11.10.25 Hall A, 11.10.25 Hall B, 12.10.25 Hall A)
- The presenter will present on the main podium of conference halls during the RISING star sessions
- Each selected candidate will be allotted 8 minutes for presentation followed by 2 minutes discussion and Honour of Award.







#### RISING Star Award Guidelines

#### **Submission Guidelines**

- Power-point presentation submission is mandatory.
- Power-point slides limit: 20
- Structure: Background, Methods/Case description, Results/Findings, Conclusion/Clinical impact.
- Only one submission per candidate is permitted.
- Work must be original and not previously published or presented at a national/international conference.

#### **Selection Process and Judging Criteria**

- Presentations will be peer-reviewed by the ISHNR Scientific Committee.
- Top 3 presentations will be shortlisted for oral presentation in the RISING Star Award session.
- Selection will be based on scientific merit, originality, clinical impact/relevance, and clarity of objectives & methodology.
- Powerpoint presentation Submission Deadline: Tuesday, 30 September, 2025
- Notification of Selection: 03.10.2025


